Dear Parents/Carers

You may remember a few weeks ago we held a cookie sale and raised a magnificent sum of £154.25 for IN-Vision, which was a fantastic achievement!

The Wren Interact Club's next charity event is a fund raiser for Children in Need. It is being held on Friday 18 November. A number of different activities will be taking place on this day:

- This will be a non-uniform day, with a suggested donation of £1 per student. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for school.
- We have also organised a competition to fit in with the 'Spotacular' theme of this year's Children in Need fundraising campaign. The student in each year group who is wearing the most spots will win a prize and house points!
- We will be having a bake sale at lunchtime. It would be appreciated if you would volunteer to bake cupcakes, cookies or a large cake that can be cut into slices. From Monday 7 November, there will be a sign-up sheet for students in Reception to indicate their willingness to bring in their bake items for sale on 18 November. Contributions to the bake sale should be taken to the Hall at the start of the day. If your child would like to purchase a cake/biscuit after their lunch, they will need to bring in a small amount of change on the day.
- In order to encourage a positive attitude, and in addition to giving students P3s, teachers will also be awarding spots in student planners during the day. The students in each tutor group with the most spots at the end of the day will receive additional house points.
