ReadiFood Food Bank Appeal

As a local school for the local community, The Wren School has been working with the ReadiFood Food Bank (a charity organisation run by the Faith Church in Reading), that aims to collect food donations and distribute to people in need in the Reading area on a weekly basis.

Next week, all students at The Wren School will be attending assemblies to promote the work of the ReadiFood charity in order to launch our school appeal with the aim of collecting as much food aid as possible before the deadline date of Monday 1st April, 2019. The food will then be donated to the food bank ready for sorting and distributing to those in need.

We are linking this appeal with an in-school house competition so that the house that collects the most food gains the most house points to add to the overall total.

We would be hugely appreciative of any food items that you could donate to the appeal. Generally, these need to be long life products such as tinned, dried or packet items (no pasta please); in particular, tinned fruit, tinned vegetables, teabags and small packets of rice would be greatly appreciated but donations can also include toiletries, nappies, baby milk and food as well as cat food, etc. As the appeal will run up towards the Easter period, the food bank would also like to include any donated Easter Eggs within their food parcels. All donated items should be taken to Mrs Horley in room 1.03 or alternatively to any of the humanities teacher who will place the donations in the relevant house collection boxes.
