



The Wren School Uniform Policy – 2019/20

Daywear

Polo Shirt	Wren School logo white polo shirt (or plain white polo shirt if worn with Wren School jumper). Long sleeve tops, T-shirts or vest tops with visible logos are not allowed to be worn underneath the polo shirt.
Jumper	Grey v-neck Wren School logo jumper.
Trousers	Smart, plain grey tailored trousers of a style suitable for school. Jeans, denim, studded, very tight trousers or leggings are not to be worn.
Skirt (girls)	Smart, plain grey, pleated knee-length skirt of a style suitable for school. Stretch fabric or short skirts are not allowed.
Coat and accessories	Coat and accessories suitable for school. Coats, hats, scarves and gloves are not allowed to be worn in lessons, unless special permission has been granted.
Shoes	Black leather or leather-look shoes of a style suitable for school. Canvas (or other fabric), visible logos or additional colours, including white soles, are not allowed.
Jewellery	Students are allowed to wear a watch, which must be removed for PE lessons. They may wear one pair of plain round stud earrings only in the ear lobe. Earrings must be small and unobtrusive and gold or silver in colour. Earrings must be taped or removed for PE lessons or if requested by a member of staff. No other jewellery is allowed; this includes but is not restricted to: rings, body piercing jewellery, bracelets, charity bands and necklaces. Students will be required to remove any item of jewellery, other than a watch, immediately if requested to do so by a member of staff, who may decide to confiscate the item for the remainder of the school day.
Hairstyle	No extremes of fashion. No patterns or bright colours. Long hair should be tied back with a discreet fastening when requested by a member of staff, for example during PE, science or technology lessons.
Make up	No visible make-up should be worn. Students are not allowed to wear coloured nail varnish. Students will be required to remove make-up or nail varnish immediately if requested to do so by a member of staff.

PE Kit

PE shirt	Wren School PE shirt (which is made of breathable fabric). A plain black T-shirt or vest top may be worn underneath this in cold weather. Long sleeve tops or T-shirts with visible logos are not allowed to be worn underneath the PE shirt. The Wren PE shirt is not allowed to be worn underneath the school white polo top during the day. Students will be requested to remove this if it is seen by a member of staff and may be sanctioned.
Shorts/ Trousers	Either plain black school-type shorts; plain black tracksuit bottoms or plain black leggings are allowed. Short or tight-fitting shorts are not allowed. Large brand names and additional colours are not allowed, e.g. stripes, on any item of clothing. Shorts and tracksuit bottoms are not allowed to be worn underneath school trousers, even if the student has PE that day. If seen, they will be asked to remove them and may be sanctioned.
Fleece	Optional. Black, Wren School logo fleece may be worn in addition to Wren School PE shirt in cold weather. This item of clothing should not be worn to other lessons except for PE. Additionally, students could wear a plain black jumper which has no visible or large logos. Hooded and zipped tops are not allowed for safety reasons.
Trainers	Students are expected to change into trainers for PE/Games lessons. Canvas shoes are not allowed. Trainers with non-black soles are expected as this limits the damage on the sports hall floor. Football boots with moulded (round) studs or plastic screw in studs must be worn on the All Weather Pitch (AWP) surface (please see Appendix 1). Students must not wear any football boots with metal, or blade style studs on the AWP. Please see the additional footwear guidance (Appendix 1). For the MUGA, students may wear the same trainers as they wear in the sports hall; it is their responsibility to keep them clean for indoor lessons.
Shin Pads & Socks	Students are expected to wear shin pads for football for safety reasons. In the absence of shin pads, students cannot participate in the competitive element of the game play. Students are expected to wear long, plain black football socks for sports such as football and rugby.
Gum Shields	Students are strongly advised to wear a gum shield for rugby. When representing the school in competitive league matches a gum shield is compulsory.
Jewellery	All jewellery in PE is expected to be removed. Plasters or tape over earrings is not acceptable for the safety of the student and their peers. Students will be told to remove earrings and a sanction will be set for non-compliance. Watches, including sports watches, must also be removed for PE.

Requests to vary the uniform policy

The Wren School and the Headteacher will consider carefully any reasonable request to vary the policy, in particular to meet the needs of any individual student to accommodate their religion or belief, ethnicity, disability or other special considerations.

Non-compliance with uniform policy

Form leaders, supported by the pastoral leaders, will be responsible for regular monitoring of The Wren School uniform policy.

Non-compliance with uniform policy may result in the following sanctions:

- A note will be made in the student's planner to inform parents that an item of uniform needs correction.
- The student will be sent to the pastoral leader, if the form leader is unable to resolve the situation, who will record the detail and issue a uniform card that indicates an agreed date for resolution. Students will be expected to produce this card when requested by a member of staff, as evidence that the uniform issue is being addressed. Uniform cards will only be given if appropriate contact is made from home to school.
- Parents/carers will be contacted.
- Students will be isolated from their peers at break and lunchtime.
- Parents/carers may be asked to bring the correct uniform into school.
- Students may be sent home from school to change if extreme challenges to the uniform policy are made.
- Missing or incorrect PE kit, without a note to explain the reasons for this, will lead to a 20 minute sanction in the first instance.
