Mathematics and Literacy Catch Up Funding 2018-2019

The impact of the £19 000 received from last year.

On entry just over 40% of students did not reach the standard score of 100 in Reading SATs, 36% did not reach the standard score of 100 in mathematics and 34% did not reach the standard score of 100 in their grammar.

By the end of Year 7 teacher assessment and testing place students on flight paths. This is based on the work completed in year 7 and the depth of knowledge shown across the year. Staff are asked to band students. The results show that 20.9% of this group of students had made enough progress and providing they continue to work as they are they could achieve a good pass at GCSE English. 27.3% of the group were banded in mathematics to achieve a good pass.

The work that has been completed in literacy and numeracy this year the fore suggests that 1/5 of the group have caught up in English and just over ¼ have caught up in maths. Although progress has been made it is clear that these students still need support to enable them to reach a pass grade at GCSE level.
