

Remote Learning Term 3

If your child is unable to complete the remote learning due to illness then you should report the child's absence in the usual way.

We want to ensure your child:

1. Has the highest quality and standard of remote learning as possible.
2. Is safe and well.

Your child's account details are the same details they would use to log into a computer at school, but in the email format. This means username@wren.excalibur.org.uk – please see email YouTube for full details (above).

For ALL students learning will look like this:

- Students will follow their **usual timetable**
- Lessons will **last 40 minutes**
- Lessons will **begin at the usual time**
- **ALL** lessons will be titled in this way: Date – Subject – topic, for example: TUES 5 JAN – Maths – Pythagoras
- **Form time** will be live via the chat function or real time live at 8.50am **every day**. *Real time live means the teacher will broadcast live to students.*

For all KS3 students:

- Lessons will be narrated, this means your child can hear, as well as read, the information.
- Your child may be directed to pre-planned videos – these are very high quality.
- Your child should have a real time live lesson at least once a week.
- A quiz, or an activity which checks your child's understanding will happen every fortnight.
- If your child is stuck they should email the department helpdesk – details are below.
- Work is set, and submitted, on MS Teams.
- If your child's teacher does not see, or hear from your child within a week they will contact home via email or telephone to find out why your child is not completing their learning.
- If your child does not have access to the technology they need to contact their form teacher.

The new KS3 email helpdesks:

Each department now has a "Helpdesk" which will be monitored daily. At KS3 your child should contact this email if they are stuck or need further help.

For all KS4 and KS5 students:
