



## The Wren School Uniform Policy – 2021/2022

### Daywear

<b>Polo Shirt</b>	Wren School logo white polo shirt (or plain white polo shirt if worn with Wren School jumper).
<b>Jumper</b>	Grey v-neck Wren School logo jumper.
<b>Trousers</b>	Grey trousers, of formal convention cut in a plain material (no skinny fit).
<b>Skirt</b>	Smart, plain grey, pleated knee-length skirt of (no skinny fit).
<b>Coat</b>	A plain outside coat (no hoodies or tracksuit tops)
<b>Shoes</b>	Formal black polishable shoes (no trainers or trainer like shoes).
<b>Jewellery</b>	Jewellery is not permitted, except for two plain studs (one in each earlobe) and a wristwatch.
<b>Hairstyle</b>	No extremes of style (no patterns, lines or unnatural colours). Long hair should be tied back for some lessons.
<b>Make up</b>	No visible make-up should be worn. No nail varnish or false nails are allowed.

### PE Kit

<b>PE shirt</b>	Wren School PE shirt
<b>Shorts/ Trousers</b>	Either plain black shorts, tracksuit bottoms or sports leggings.
<b>Fleece</b>	Optional. Black, Wren School logo fleece or plain black sports jumper. Hooded and zipped tops are not allowed for safety reasons.
<b>Trainers</b>	Sports trainers or football boots with round plastic studs depending on activity (see below)
<b>Shin Pads &amp; Socks</b>	Shin pads, gum shields as required.
<b>Jewellery</b>	All jewellery in PE is expected to be removed.
