## Year 11: Drama Trip - Top Hat Production: Thursday 4th November 2021

I am delighted to announce that we will be running a trip to The Mill Sonning Theatre to watch a production of Top Hat, on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2021. This is a fantastic opportunity for Year 11 to experience Live Theatre since the re-opening of local theatres. It links closely to several aspects of the GCSE specification and will broaden students' horizons as well as supporting their academic understanding in preparation for the end of year exams.

Students also need to have a covid passport or proof of a negative lateral flow test. This can be achieved quickly and easily by downloading the NHS App and using it to show either your vaccination or lateral flow test status.

If you would like your child to attend the trip, please complete the expression of interest form below and return by Friday,  $22^{nd}$  October to Miss Stevens.


