Introducing Interventions 7

During tutor time, the Learning Mentors run intervention sessions, which is an opportunity for some students to participate in different groups to learn more about themselves to provide them the tools needed for the future:

Nurture - encourage students to discuss their concerns and help build relationships.

Self-esteem - support students in identifying their strengths and developing their self-esteem.

Sensory circuits - physical activities in order to focus concentration in readiness for the day.

ADHD - identify where students have difficulties and learning coping strategies to enable them to manage school life.

We also run **Maths** and **English** support groups to improve their fundamental numeracy
